Modoc Medical Center is accepting applications for a full-time, benefit eligible C.N.A. for the Activities Department in our Warnerview Skilled Nursing facility. Reporting to the on-shift Charge Nurse, Nurse Manager, or Nursing Supervisor, the certified nursing assistant is responsible for performing daily resident care activities, in his/her scope of practice, of an assigned group of residents, documenting care given and all resident observations accordingly. <a href="Duties include">Duties include (but not limited to):</a>

- Delivers restorative care to residents according to established protocol.
- Works in conjunction with other team members to build a team.
- Performs or assists with personal hygiene on residents.
- Monitors and records the resident's vital signs accurately and according to established procedures including temperature, pulse, respirations, blood pressure, and pain scale.
- Assists residents with activity and transfer including position change, dangling, ambulation, R.O.M., use of walker, cane, crutches, prosthetic devises and gait belt use.
- Assists residents with food and nutrition including passes trays, provides set-up assistance, assists residents to eat, supplies nourishments, passes water, charts food percentages and intake/output accurately.
- Admits residents to and discharges residents from the facility according to established procedures and assists in making them and their families oriented and comfortable.
- Cares for residents in isolation following established procedures. Abides by Standard precautions.
- Assists in meeting residents and their family's emotional, psychological and social needs while in the facility. Notifies the charge nurse, nurse manager or nursing supervisor when problems arise.
- Helps support residents and their families during and after death and does postmortem care according to established procedure.
- Observes safety rules while transporting residents per wheelchair. Uses gait belt appropriately when ambulating and/or transferring residents who require it. Reports any equipment problems or safety hazards to the nursing supervisor or nurse manager.
- Check to make sure the dining room is up for meals and prepare handwashing containers and washcloths.
- Set up coffee, water, ice cart for between meals and assist with handing out snacks to residents.
- Provide group activities to residents between scheduled activities with the assistance of Activity Director and Activity staff.
- Participates in ward discussions and/or resident care planning regarding resident care issues. Offers suggestions for improved resident care.
- Performs additional duties as requested or assigned by the charge nurse or nursing administration.

## **Minimum Qualifications:**

- Current C.N.A. licensure preferred; if non-certified, must become certified within four months of hire.
- Current BLS level CPR certification.
- Previous clinical experience training and experience in a nursing home/ hospital setting desirable.
