4-Month Training Program | Flexible Evening & Weekend Schedule

Modoc Medical Center (MMC) is accepting applications for our upcoming Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) Training Class **starting Tuesday, November 5, 2025**. This program prepares students to provide pre-hospital emergency care through classroom instruction and hands-on field experience, and equips them for EMT certification and potential employment with MMC.

What EMTs Do

- Provide emergency medical care within EMT scope of practice
- Safely operate ambulances during emergency and routine calls
- Communicate clearly with patients, families, and team members
- Support care coordination with nursing and hospital staff

What You'll Gain in Our Program

- Classroom instruction and hands-on field training
- Support and mentorship from experienced Paramedics and instructors
- Preparation for California EMT certification
- Foundation for a career in emergency medical services
- Job opportunities with MMC upon certification, starting at \$19.99/hr

Eligibility

- Must be at least 18 years of age by July 1, 2026
- Must complete a pre-employment physical, background check, and drug screen
- Commitment to complete the full program and certification requirements

Class Details & Tuition

- Wednesdays and Fridays, 5:30pm–9:30pm; every other Saturday, 9am–6pm
- Class runs through mid-March 2026 (end date may vary)
- Tuition: \$500 per attendee (payment plans available)
- Current MMC employees *may* be eligible for tuition assistance if criteria is met
- Students are **NOT** paid for attending class
